

The discussion to change AYY's scholarship regulation already began with the last Representative Council term, when a need for the following change was expressed.

The community scholarship does not account for volunteer tasks undertaken during the application year. However, the greatest use for a community scholarship is just when the volunteer is still holding their post and has less time for study and work. If the scholarships are aimed to reward for active student activities, it is much more useful for the motivation of the active themselves and their financial situation to receive thanks when motivation and perseverance are still needed, and the individual in question has strong ties to the community.

The proposal for change for the Scholarship Regulation, section 10.

Old

Scoring takes into account those positions and duties which have been completed before the end of the ongoing year and those meetings of university administration and AYY's representative council, which took place before the beginning of the ongoing year.

New

Scoring takes into account those positions and duties which the applicant has held in or is acting in during the applications, and the meetings of university administration and AYY's representative council which the applicant has participated in.
